### **Health and Safety Prequalification Assessment - Contractors Health & Safety (CHAS) Assessment Scheme**

I have now completed my review assessment of your application to continue as a CHAS compliant company. You will recall you were required to respond to a number of health and safety questions that were used to complete my assessment of your policy, organisation and arrangements for health and safety.

I am pleased to inform you that I have assessed your application as Compliant and you continue to be a CHAS registered contractor. I have entered this outcome on the CHAS database and can now be viewed by all clients and members of the CHAS scheme, documents related to your application process are also available to view on the database which allows clients to consider the quality of your application. You should not however take compliance within the CHAS scheme as a right of entry to a member approved or select list. Members have the right to ask for additional H&S information on future applications or at invitation to tender.

CHAS do not issue certificate of "CHAS Compliance" as this could, in certain circumstances lead to abuse of the CHAS copyright and loss of revenue. You are however welcome to tell your clients you have been assessed as compliant by CHAS but they will need to seek confirmation through the scheme manager.

If you feel you would like your company to become a "CHAS Accredited" contractor and receive a Certificate of Accreditation, with license for the use of the CHAS logo on your company livery and stationery, please go to <http://www.chas.gov.uk/Accreditation.asp> for more information and to download the one page Accreditation application form.

You should be aware that to be an accredited company you must commit to an annual CHAS assessment.

One of the aims of the CHAS scheme is to reduce unnecessary duplication. In the event your company is asked to complete a CHAS or similar questionnaire by one of our members (list on the web site) please contact them before completing that application to verify what is required.
